The Monty Teasers finished fourth last season and have recruited Steve Bebb who will definitely add some strength. The first weeks honours belonged to Scott Clifford's Tigers who had Shaun James 3/3 and Mark Crees 2/3 introduced to the side. Dave Woosnam 2/2 sealed the match points in the tenth frame against Russ Evans.

The battle of the promoted sides Cefn Coch A and The Herbs ended in a one sided 10-4 win for the Kerry side. Jon Edwards making his return to our league with a 2/2 as Chris Chaney with a 2/3 made sure his side took two points after beating Rich Bennett in the last frame of the second session. The Herbs will now relish this weeks match at home to the Jockey B, as Cefn Coch take on the Monty Misfits who laboured to a 7-7 draw away to the Lion Cubs.

In a match littered with errors from both teams, it seemed the most likely result with both sides not doing enough to take both points. An impromptu kick on the black for the seventh frame against Nigel Owen resulted in the cubs Mr consistent taking out a superb clearance. John Roberts was Cubs hero, winning the last frame to share the spoils. Conor Jones with a 3/3 and continued his good form for the Misfits.




