

Jockey A go top after Full Montys draw with Misfits.

A powerful early session saw the Full Montys race in to a 4-0 lead which included two 7 ballers from Bob Pritchard 2/3 and Jake Ottaway. That lead was only reduced after Carl Williams some how took out Glyn Davies. With his last ball covered over a pocket by Glyn's safety play, Carl took on a double and through in a cannon for good measure to leave himself perfect on the black. That was Glyn's first taste of defeat this season so far. That saw the Misfits win the next three to restore parity, before Bob took out his second 7 baller. The Misfits went in to the lead for the first time with Jason Stokes and Aled Evans taking it to 6-5. Glyn bounced back to knock in a 7 baller and the last two frames were shared for a hard fought point for both sides. Probably a fair result given both teams can reflect on missed chances.

In the same venue, the Jockey A inflicted a third defeat on Llanbadarn. Returning from his Welsh call up in Ireland the previous week, Carl Clark chipped in with a 3/3 and a 7 baller. This match also found it's way to 4-4 such was the quality of players at both teams disposal. The next two frames were shared with Dave Morgan 3/3 being his sides top performer. That left Tomos Lloyd And Matt Davies (both 2/3) to win the last two frames to seal both points and in doing so, go to the top of the table.

A superb comeback from the Jockey B after they found themselves 7-1 down saw them win all of the last six frames against the Talbot Tigers. The Tigers will be kicking themselves on not being able to close the gap to third as they remain in a healthy fourth place. Jake Owen held his nerve to beat top Tiger Mark Cress in the last frame.

The Nomads recorded back to back wins with a tremendous 8-6 away win at The Sws. Rob Griffiths and Alan Walker, both 3/3 did most of the damage which lifts them two points clear of The Sws. Early a 2/3 from Staff Jones and a 7 baller wasn't quite enough to power his side on in a match that saw Mark Jones continue his excellent form with a 2/3.

The Lion Cubs climbed to fifth with a 9-5 away win at Cefn Coch A. It wasn't until the latter stages and leading 6-5 that the Cubs clicked in to gear. Mark Woosnam 2/3, Llyr Thomas 2/3 and finally Nigel Owen 2/3 after Rich Bennett 3/3 for Cefn Coch had tried to keep his side in it.



As for the Zimmers, they`ll want to put some more points on the board soon before they end up in a relegation battle.

The Desert Rats are still searching for their first win of the season but had to be content with a draw last week, at home to the Red Lion. The Lion themselves are blowing hot and cold so far but started the match in red hot form, racing to a 4-1 lead. Rich Wyatt was once again in good form, chipping in with another 3/3. John Bunn 2/3 also helped the Lions to the brink of a win but up stepped Ian McKee to win only his second frame of the season In the last to

save the day for the Rats. Gareth Bowen with his 2/3 hit joint top of the Player of the Year award with Rich Wyatt.

The match between the Outcasts and BullnHeifer was postponed and will be played soon with the Outcasts hoping a week off will give them a fresh start as they look to kick start their season.

Although the Bowlers are close to the bottom, they have proved they can mix it with the top of the table so will expect to see performances put in to points soon.

The Outbowlers are on a run of four straight wins after beating the Dolau A 12-2. A 3/3 for Jordan Lewis in the one sided match that keeps the Dolau searching for their first point of the season. Geraint Woosnam and Ian Bywater were the two Dolau players to experience a potted black.

The Jury had their second win of the season after they came away from Mo's Misfits with a 9-5 win. In the foot of the table clash and an evenly matched contest, Tom Young with a 3/3 for the Jury proved to be the difference as the Jurors sentenced the Misfits to their sixth defeat of the season.
