Jockey B stun Full Montys to give Jockey A title hope

If they are to leave the league at the end of the season as is rumoured, then the Jockey B have played their part in throwing the title wide open. All ready this season they have beaten the Jockey A 8-6 and went even better last week by beating the long time title favourites Full Montys 10-4. After 7 balling Sedgy to bring the score back to 2-1, Glyn Davies then had to sit out the rest of the night, and see the scoreline move on to 5-2. Callum Bishop then took notable wins against Drew Hughes and Mike Williams with Sedgy composing himself to beat Carl Guntrip to see the scores move on to 6-3. Up stepped Otis Powell to play back to back frames against Drew and then Carl, beating both for an excellent win.

That will have been cheered loudly by the Jockey A who cantered to an 13-1 win over the Teasers. Matt Davies with a 3/3 and the frame winner versus Nigel Roberts with Matt's brother Mark being the only Teaser to win a frame.

On Friday night, the Jockey A played their match in hand and beat The Herbs 13-1 to set up an enthralling climax to our season this Sunday, as the top two meet. If only this match could be live streamed.

Llanbadarn are in pole position to finish third in their return to the league after they demolished the Cubs 13-1. Given the experience of the Cubs, that was a surprise scoreline, with Barry Owen only winning the first frame for the Cubs in the twelfth. That win means Llanbadarn only need a draw against Cefn Coch A, given their frame aggregate over the Misfits.

Five frames in a row after they went 2-0 down to the Nomads, gave the Misfits the momentum to kick on. Frames were then shared until lee Harris completed his 3/3 and finally Carl Williams beat birthday boy Andy Coppin for the match. Rhys Butler of the Nomads was in good form with a 3/3 and two 7 ballers.

Climbing to seventh in the league is The Sws after they had little trouble against Cefn

Coch, finishing with an 11-3 win. It's been a superb season for Mark Jones and he capped that with a 3/3 and a 7 baller in the match frame against Rich Williams.

Jesters win back to back titles after defeating BullnHeifer in Div Two The Jockey Jesters have put in a real shift this season after their Third Division title last year. Needing one win from their remaining two matches, they achieved that at the first time of asking although they found themselves 3-1 down to the Bulls before Wayne Olden steadied the ship with the first of his 3/3. It was his third frame win in the thirteenth that sealed the title frame against Phil Lewis and they can now enjoy the Summer and look forward to the Premiership next season. Jake Owen with a 2/2 was the other 100% performer for the Jesters with Kev Lewis 3/3 for the Bulls. The battle for the runners up spot is on between the Jones and Co and Cefn Coch B. both are locked on 25 points with the Jones's having a match in hand. Tudor Jones 3/3 and Clive Langford 2/3 continue to perform well for the villagers who needed Tudor's last frame win over Barry Shafe to seal both points in a tight match versus the Bowling Ballers, eventually winning 8-6. Rhys Bell was the Ballers top player with a 3/3. The Ballers who sit fourth now require the Jones's and Cefn Coch to lose their remaining fixtures to stand any chance of a quick return to the top division. The Outcasts are a completely different team since the turn of the year and will give any team a run for their money as the Queues found out. With the Queues always in the top half of the division, they only need a little more consistency to be able to put in a title push but the Outcasts took the to 6-6. Up stepped Owain Wilding 2/3 and finally Neal Pratten 2/3 to win both of the last two frames for the Monty outfit. The Outcasts have now been involved in seven 8-6 matches this season but on the wrong side last week. The Zimmers are up to sixth and their highest place this season after they defeated the Desert Rats 8-6 thanks to a Mitchy Harris last frame win over Anthony Wilson. Kev Mitchell with a 2/3 and a recent return of form (11 from his last 14), proving his class. Terry Marshall with a 2/2 for an improving Zimmers who have won five from the last six. The Severn St Mob are back to winning was after nine matches, beating the Red Lion 9-5. Winning eight from the last nine, the Sportsman side are still hovering mid table after their early sea-

son promising start. Steve Jones with the winning match frame, sandwiched between 7 ballers from Ted Pryce 2/2 and Tudor Lloyd Kerry 1/2.
