Jockey A win Premiership title with Full Montys draw


After the Jockey B defeated the Full Montys the week before, the Monty Club side knew only a win would be enough for them to retain their title against rivals Jockey A who have played second fiddle to them for most of the season. In the final day clash between the sides, Mike Williams set the Montys off with the first frame. Aled Lloyd then got the Jockeys up and running before Drew recorded his 14th 7 baller of the season. That was the first of six 7 ballers in this match, with Carl Clark recording one against fellow Player of the Year contender Bob Pritchard. Bob then composed himself to record his first of two 7 ballers and in doing so, winning the coveted POTY award. That brought the scores to 4-3 to the Jockey who only needed a draw. Carl Clark took that on to 5-3 and then back to back 7 ballers for Tomos Lloyd and Aled Lloyd meant that the Jockey reclaimed the title in style. Congratulations to them and also the Full Montys who continue to set the leagues standard with both sides over the 100+ frame aggregate. Such was the interest in this match, the score was viewed more than 700 times by the time the match finished.

Llanbadarn who returned to the league this season ended in third place after their 11-3 demolition of second from bottom Cefn Coch. Justin Bishop with a 3/3 and a 7 baller for the match frame in the ninth.

An up and down season for the Misfits as they lost 8-6to the Talbot Tigers who ended the season in a very respectable fifth place. Scott Clifford with a 2/3 and the winning frame against Carl Williams. That meant the Misfits dropped to fourth place after their third place last season. Bottom placed the Herbs put up a good showing against the Lion Cubs but fell in the last frame, with Barry Owen 3/3 holding his nerve to beat Jon Edwards for both points. The Cubs finish sixth in the last prize money position. After their heroics against the Full Montys, the Jockey B fell 9-5 to The Sws. Mark Jones for the Sws ended his personal campaign with 30 frames and fourth in the PO-

TY, a great achievement given the strength of the league. Josh Allen winning their match winning frame against Julian Marsh. The jungle drums are out already and maybe the Jockey B may not be disbanding after all, with a few new recruits possible heading their way. Finally the Nomads took the honours against the Teasers with a 10-4 win with two 7 ballers for Rob Griffiths 3/3 and the match frame for Andy Coppin 2/3. Both sides feature in the bottom half of the table and would have hoped for better.

Well done to both sides on a superb achievement.

Cefn Coch B just missed out after they could only draw against bottom side Red Lion. In fact it was the Lion who made a mockery of their league position by taking seven of the first nine frames with John Bunn 3/3 being the top Lion. Coch B rallied in the second half to muster a draw and will start next season as one of the title favourites.

The Bowling Ballers completed the up hill task of beating the Queues after they fell 4-0 behind to eventually win 8-6. Gareth McMurdo finishing the job in the last frame when he beat Neal Pratten for the match and complete his 3/3. jow Bowman-Long with the same return for the Queues.

An excellent 8-6 win for the BullnHeifer at home to the Severn St Mob thanks to a 3/3 for Kev Lewis after they fell 5-1 behind. That moved on to 6-2 but then the Bulls raised their game to win all of the remaining frames with only Ted Pryce 2/2 scoring full marks for the town side.

For the majority of the season, the Outcasts looked nailed on for demotion but their form bettered in the New Year. Last week they drew to the Desert Rats in a typical end of season match that needed Andy Meek, Anthony Wilson and finally Callum Lovell to win the last three frames for the point. 


