The Tigers play the Teasers this week whilst the Misfits will hope to bounce back against The Sws.


The Sws raced in to a 3-1 lead against title favourites Full Montys in a match that had five 7 ballers. Unfortunately for The Sws, you can never write off one of the leagues top sides and back they came with Drew Hughes 3/3 and two 7 ballers, and a 2/2 for Daf Rowlands. That set up Carl Guntrip to beat Ashley Isaac in the twelfth for an emphatic 10-4 win and keep them with a 100% record as they play against the champions Jockey A this week who had their bye last week.

The Nomads are also on 2/2 wins this season after they beat the Lion Cubs. That seemed unlikely after they went 3-0 down. Back to back 7 ballers for Alan Walker 3/3 and Dan Stephens 2/3 against a luckless John Roberts seemed to knock the stuffing out of the Cubs as the Nomads went in to a 5-3 lead. Mark Woosnam 2/3 stopped the rot however but that was only temporary when Josh Owen 3/3 took his team over the line in the twelfth and they will look forward to this weeks fixture against the Jesters.

The Jockey Jesters will rue the 8-6 defeat at the hands of the Teasers especially as they lead 6-5 with Martin Williams 3/3 and Ryan Hamer 2/3 being the main protagonists. Russ Evans then Ed Lewis won the next two to set up Danny Francis who beat Will Beddoes in the last frame. The Teasers can now look forward to a home match against the Tigers but will look to get off to a better start after going 3-1 behind against the Jesters.

The Jockey A and the Dragons had their byes last week and play the Full Montys and Lion Cubs respectively this week.




