That win will have reverberated around the league and next door where the Jockey A recalled Carl Clark to the side as they faced the Monty Misfits. After Carl Hanson won the first frame, the Misfits had no answer to the Jockey who won the next six frames. Callum Bishop is proving his worth to his call up as he won 3/3 that included two 7 ballers. Without Aled and Tomos Lloyd, it was captain Dave Manuel who sealed an excellent 9-5 win when he beat Mark Crees.

The Jockey Jesters finally have their first win of the season after they beat an under sorts Lion Cubs 8-6. Winning both of the first two sessions 3-2 set them on their way which left Martin Williams and Wayne Olden both 3/3 to close the match out as the Jesters climb above the Cubs. Ed Jones and Nigel Owen both 3/3 were the only Cubs successful players.

A topsy turvy match between the Dragons and The Sws last week as the Dragons raced in to a 3-0 lead. A catalogue of missed chances then let the Sws back in to lead 6-3 with Adam Jones 3/3 in superb form. Alen Beefy Jones then hit a double to 6-6 before Adam got his third. Ashley Isaac then missed a chance to let Rich Evans in to seal the draw with both teams lying lower in the league than they would expect to.

Matt Davies leads the stats with 12 frames. Next is Mike Williams with 10. Callum Bishop and Drew Hughes are on 9 frames with five players on 8.

Going in to a 3-0, the Ballers then dropped the next three frames but a 3/3 for Rhys Bell and Richard Morgan restored their advantage which they held on to.



It was Rhys 2/3 for the Younguns who won the only frame in the first seven for the youthful side who sit fourth from bottom in the league. Josh Righelato also with a 3/3 for the Rats.

Cefn Coch B climb to fifth after they beat the Lion Caerhowel 8-6. Rob Francis with a 2/3 and a 7 baller set up his colleague Robbie James 2/3 to beat Rich Wyatt in the thirteenth for the match. That leaves the Lions with only two points after six matches as they look for some consistency to stay in the division despite strengthening with Summer recruit Roger Lovatt.

A superb 9-5 win for the Zimmers against the Monty Melts was aided by Alan Davies 2/3 as he enjoyed his best week of the season, which included the match winning frame against Alex Galvin. The signing of Huw Roberts 3/3 has been inspirational by captain Owen Durbridge after the departure of Johnny Jerman and he's repaid that faith with a 62% win rate after a few seasons away from pool. Only mark Hamer with a 3/3 for the Melts had any fortune as both teams remain mid table.

In the player of the year stats, Richard Morgan leads with 11 frames with Rhys Jones on 10. seven players are on 9 wins.

The Exchange are a bit of an unknown entity this season and find themselves fourth after beating the league stalwarts, Judges 9-5. Harry Gannon has been in fine form this season and he clocked up another 3/3 for the Exchange who also had Andy Jarman recording the same. The Judges will look back at losing five frames on the bounce in the middle of the match that cost them dearly as most of their matches this season have only had the odd one or two frame swing to change the result.

In the battle of mid way, the Jury and Treacles had to settle for a 7-7 draw which may feel like a point lost for the Treacles after they lead 3-0 and 7-5. Steve Best 2/2 had put them on the hill only for the Jury's Kev Hodges 2/3 and finally Adam Bowen to win his only frame of the night but an important one to level the scores at the death.

Well done to the Brexit Bowlers who have gained their first point of the season after drawing with fellow strugglers the Woodenspooners. Stephen Ross with a 3/3 was the Brexiteers hero with Kyle Challinor 2/3 getting them to the first point at 7-5. back came the Spoons with Jamie Woodhouse 2/3 gaining his team a hard fought point.

In the divisional stats award, Phil Lewis and Huw Humphreys share top spot with 11 frames. Graham Lewis, Kev Lewis, Daryl Haynes and Huw Wainwright follow with 10 frames with another five players on 9.




