## Tigers stun the Jockey to go third in the Premier League

The reigning champions Jockey A seem to have lost last seasons sparkle at the moment and last week, the Tigers could smell blood. That gives them a five point lead at the top, whilst the Misfits drop to fourth.

The Nomads didn't have all of their own way when they played lowly Dragons as the fixture entered the last session locked at 5-5. That was as good as it got for the Dragons who need to start turning decent performances in to points before it's too late. The Nomads ran out winners of the last four frames with Rob Griffiths holding his nerve to beat Beefy Jones in the thirteenth for both points. Josh Owen 3/3 was the Nomads top performer.

Honours even in the tie between the Sws and the Lion Cubs as Woosnam beat Jones in the battle of the Mark's in the last frame. The Sws started off well going in to a 3-0 lead but let the under performing Cubs back in to the match with Barry Owen 3/3 giving them a slight advantage of 6-5. Josh Allen also with a 3/3 for the villagers put them on the hill at 7-6 only for the match to end all square at the death and a welcome point for the Cubs.

Glyn Davies, Mike Williams, Drew Hughes and Matt Davies are joint leaders of the divisional award with 14 frames. Mark Jones, Carl Guntrip and Mark Brassington are next with 12 frames.


Sunday Dec 7th is a free week for Premier League players. A good chance to catch up on postponed league or cup matches.

Rich Wyatt and Roger Lovatt both 3/3's were the Lion's pride as they inflicted the third defeat in a row for the Mob. Dan Rowlands with a 3/3 for the Mob as they have a daunting task against the Newbees this week.

In the Monty derby between the Queues and Melts, the Queues raced in to a 7-1 lead only to see that whittle away slightly. Back came the Melts with a run of four frames to narrow the gap to 7-5 behind with Michael Goodwin 2/2 being their main player. That only provoked a response as Llion Jones and Owain Wilding both 3/3 closed out the match and take a 9-5 win.

Rich Morgan leads the player of the year award with 15 frames. Rhys Jones is on 14 with five players on 12 frames.

The Spoons managed to lead 2-1 but that was all they were limited to as a 3/3 for Jacob Jones and Kye Brooks closed the match out. They lie fourth in the league but only one point behind the leading pack.

In the bottom half of the table, the Judges ran out 10-4 winners over the Outbowlers with Steve Owen 3/3 being top judge and this case, chief executioner as it was his frame in the eleventh against Callum Hamilton which claimed both points. 2/2 for the Outbowlers Tristan Jones. That's back to back wins for them but the test will come this week as they face the Red Lion.

The match this week between the Buck and Back Lane Bowlers may prove pivotal as we reach the half way stage of the season.




