After Steve Jones had won the first frame for the SSM, the Newbees won seven frames on the bounce with the Robbie Hartshorn 2/3 hammering home the final nail in the match in the tenth against Clive Jerman. They now sit just one point behind the leaders at the half-way stage.

An excellent draw for the Monty Melts who will feel slightly annoyed that it wasn't two points as they took on one of the early season favourites Cefn Coch B. The melts lead 3-2 but found themselves 6-4 down with Rob's Davies and Francis both 2/2 in the first two sessions. In the basement battle between the Outbowlers and Woodenspooners, the Bowling Club side came through from 5-4 up to win all of the remaining five frames for a healthy 10-4 win.
